COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT PUBLIC HEARING

Mayor Ann K. Leppanen opened the second public hearing for the CDBG program. Mayor Leppanen stated that this meeting was called to allow all citizens to provide input concerning the project that was awarded under the 2019 Community Development Block Grant Program. The town has created its first capital investment plan and decided to apply for funds on behalf of the Bluff Town Water Study in the incorporated boundaries of Bluff. The Mayor is the project manager for the Bluff Town Water Study. The Mayor explained that the application was successful in the regional rating and ranking process and the Bluff Town Water Study was granted an award amount of \$96,300 with the town providing \$500 in matching funds. The Mayor explained the project to those in attendance. The Mayor then asked for any comments, questions and concerns from the audience. Ed Dobson wanted to know why his water pressure had decreased and would new property development on his line make it worse? Barbara Day wanted to know if she was on the same line because she also had a decrease in water pressure. The Mayor indicated that she would attend the next Bluff Water Works meeting and ask these questions. The Mayor stated that copies of the capital investment plan are available if anyone would like a copy. There were no more comments and the hearing was adjourned at 7:41 p.m.
