COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT (CDBG) PUBLIC HEARING:

Mayor Ann K. Leppanen opened the second public hearing for the CDBG program. Mayor Leppanen stated that this meeting was called to allow all citizens to provide input concerning the project that was awarded under the 2022 Community Development Block Grant Program. The city has amended its capital investment plan and decided to apply for funds on behalf of the Bluff Community Center ADA Project in Bluff. Mayor Leppanen is the project manager from the Bluff Community Center ADA Project. The Mayor explained that the application was successful in the regional rating and ranking process and Bluff Community Center ADA Project and grant award amount \$128,383.
