

RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN OF BLUFF TO CONTINUE TO USE ZIONS BANK AS ITS FINANCIAL INSTITUTION

WHEREAS, on November 13, 2018 by a unanimous vote the Bluff Town Council passed Resolution Number 6: "Resolution of the Town of Bluff to Use Zions Bank to Open a Financial Account;" and

WHEREAS, the Bluff Town Council opened a checking account for deposit of funds for the general fund, any enterprise fund, and Class C Road Fund; and

WHEREAS, the town of Bluff is in continued need of a banking institution to conduct its daily, regular, and ongoing business; and

WHEREAS, the Bluff town council has determined it continues to be in the best interest of the town council of Bluff to continue to use Zions Bank for its daily, regular, and ongoing financial institution.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF BLUFF, UTAH:

SECTION 1. Support Zions Bank as the Town of Bluff Banking Institution. The town council resolves to continue to use Zions Bank as its daily, regular, and ongoing financial institution.

SECTION 2. That the following town council members shall be the signatories to said accounts: Mayor Ann K. Leppanen and Council Members Hook, Murray, Sayers, and Sosa.

SECTION 3. This Resolution shall become effective upon passage.
