TOWN OF BLUFF RESOLUTION NO. 57

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE LOAN OF THE SUM OF \$32,777.65 FROM THE TOWN GENERAL FUND TO THE TOWN CLASS C ROAD FUND FOR THE PURPOSE OF PAYING FOR NEEDED ROAD IMPROVEMENTS WITHIN TOWN

The following describes the intent and purpose of this resolution:

- a. The Town has appropriated funds from the Class C Road Fund for various improvements to roads, including grading, chip sealing, the installation of culverts, and the like.
- b. The scope of road maintenance needs within the Town exceeds the balance of the Class C Road funds now held by the Town.
- c. The Town has determined that it is more efficient to complete improvements now, rather than in a piecemeal fashion over time.
- d. The Town has sufficient unencumbered funds in its General Fund to cover the deficit in the Class C Road Fund for needed maintenance.
- e. Utah law authorizes towns to make loans between a general fund and other town funds for purposes deemed reasonable or necessary by the town council. U.C.A. Section 10-5-120(6).

THEREFORE, the Town of Bluff enacts as follows:

- 1. The Town authorizes the transfer of the sum of Thirty Two Thousand Seven Hundred Seventy Seven Dollars and Sixty Five Cents (\$32,777.65) from the General Fund to the Class C Road Fund, which sum is to be expended for road maintenance and upgrading within the Town as authorized by the Town Council (the Loan). The Loan shall not accrue interest.
- 2. The Town will repay the Loan by transferring from the Class C Road fund to the General Fund three (3) payments of Ten Thousand Nine Hundred and Twenty Five Dollars and Eighty Eight Cents (\$10,925.88), which shall be paid annually on September 1, 2022, September 1, 2023, and September 1, 2024.

Approved and authorized by a majority of the Bluff Town Council; this resolution shall take effect immediately upon execution.
