Like most other commenters, I do not support the construction and frequent use of aviation facilities in the central, developed area of Bluff (except for occasional use during medical emergencies). Others have already described significant impacts that would be associated with this activity such as noise, dust, and their effects on residents, pets, wildlife, and other modes of tourism. I would add that if the town allows one such facility, how could it legally deny any future requests for similar facilities in the same area? One facility would be disturbing, but what if there were more?

If the town thinks it must accommodate this type of use, I would support it at the Bluff Airport. However I agree with Nike and Dave Stevens that aviation tourism could affect the peace of many areas beyond Bluff where flight noise is now extremely rare.
