I am writing as a private citizen to express my opposition to the Acton & SITLA petition to disconnect from the town. I do not believe the disconnection would serve the interests of the Town nor benefit its citizens. I feel it is contrary to the guidance set forth in our general plan. The inclusion of the St. Christopher's Mission, a decision grounded purely in strategy, was unjust and unfair to the Mission and the people it serves who were not included in that decision. For the record, it is important to note that the Acton family did not first come to the Town or Planning & Zoning Commission with concerns, ideas, or an interest in finding solutions. I feel they failed in their duty to try & exhaust other means to work out land use concerns before going straight to legal action.
