

RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN OF BLUFF TO APPOINT A TREASURER AND
DEPUTY TREASURER

Whereas, the Bluff Town Council voted unanimously to continue to use Zions Bank as its financial institution; and

Whereas, the Bluff Town Council voted unanimously that newly elected council member Jennifer Davila serve as Treasurer during the 2024 calendar year; and

Whereas, the Bluff Town Council voted unanimously that the signatories to the Zions Bank account are Mayor Ann Leppanen and Council Members, Hook, Hornsby, and Davila; and

Whereas, a Deputy Treasurer must be appointed when the Treasurer is absent or unable to sign all checks prepared by the Recorder; and

Whereas, the Deputy Treasurer cannot be the Recorder:

Whereas, two signatures are required on checks:


Therefore, be it resolved by the Bluff Town Council that:

1. The following Bluff Town Council Member shall be, and hereby is, appointed as the Deputy Treasurer for the purpose of signing checks when the Treasurer is absent or unable to sign: Luanne Hook.
2. If neither the Treasurer or the Deputy Treasurer are available to sign, then either Leppanen, or Council Member Britt Hornsby may sign.
3. This Resolution shall become effective upon passage.
