Hornsby motioned to open the public hearing for the Five-Year Capital Improvements Plan for Fiscal Years 2025 – 2029, Davila seconded and Leppanen, Hook, Davila, Hornsby and Sosa voted in favor

**1. Public Comment to be Taken on Five-Year Capital Improvements Plan for Fiscal Years
2025 – 2029**

Leppanen introduced the hearing and Nelson reminded this list of projects had been worked on in a work session and public meeting. She shared her screen and gave the overview and updated projects with project cost, probable cost for the town after grants, and timelines. She noted Kathleen Packish contributed the project of ADA sidewalks at the CC Park and West Park. Hook added the playground project and felt Calf Canyon Road should be in FY2025. Jim Hook asked why parks appeared several times but there was funds listed for the Bluff Cemetery, which is County owned. Leppanen has been in talks with Mack McDonald about

transferring it to Bluff and reported it will be transferred. Funds are required to bring the Bluff Cemetery District into required State compliance, which the County ignored.
