Hornsby motioned to open the public hearing for the Tentative FY2025 Budget, Davila seconded and Leppanen, Hook, Davila, Hornsby and Sosa voted in favor

1. Public Comment to be Taken on Tentative FY2025 Budget

Leppanen introduced the Tentative FY2025 Budget and Nelson presented an overview by sharing her screen and explaining several changes that had been made since the May 7th meeting. She explained increases and decreases in Administration, Roads, and Parks. Also, the CCC, grants, and needed employees. She pointed out the budget was financially conservative. Hook suggested noxious weeds be consolidated instead being in different locations. Jacob Nelson asked about the CCC, grant money and ongoing costs. Leppanen explained Tri-Hurst had a ballpark estimate of \$2,000,000 to \$3,000,000 for complete renovation of the building. Energy efficiency are part of the plan.
